# Subject: Proposed arrangements for the 53rd Session of the IOC Executive Council

As a consequence of the Covid-19 pandemic, Member States of the IOC Executive Council were consulted (cf. IOC <u>Circular Letter 2799</u> of April 3, 2020) and agreed to postpone its 53<sup>rd</sup> session initially scheduled at UNESCO Headquarters from 30 June to 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020. Unfortunately, the pandemic continues unabated around the world. Related containment measures are in place in many countries including France, and international travel is heavily affected. While continuing progress of the Commission requires guidance by Member States, the current situation makes conducting an *in praesentia* session of the Executive Council virtually impossible.

The purpose of this letter is therefore to consult you on the possibility to hold the 53<sup>rd</sup> session of the IOC Executive Council in an *online* modality, with *an agenda limited to essential issues* requiring guidance or decisions prior to the 31<sup>st</sup> IOC Assembly, currently planned for June 2021.

The IOC Officers, together with the Executive Secretary and his management team, held an online meeting on 30 September 2020 and reviewed the situation in the light of our commitments, reporting, planning and budgeting deadlines and regulatory obligations, and also taking into account the principle of dual governance and functional autonomy of the Commission within UNESCO. There is a consensus amongst the Officers to recommend the attached shortened draft agenda for an **online five-day plenary session from 3 to 9 February 2021**, preceded by online meetings of the Officers on February, 1<sup>st</sup> and of the Intersessional Financial Advisory Group on February, 2<sup>nd</sup>. Careful preparation will be undertaken to ensure the quality of the debate and allow an inclusive, transparent, and efficient decision-making process. The Secretariat is currently exploring technical means to hold the session with full interpretation and in the most efficient way, in keeping with the IOC Rule of Procedure n° 33.2 and based on the emerging best practices of UNESCO and the entire UN system and in consultation with the UNESCO Legal Advisor.

Should we obtain consensus on this proposed arrangement, the updated documentation for the online EC-53 session will be made available on а dedicated webpage at https://oceanexpert.org/event/2805. All documents prepared for the initially planned and postponed session remain available at http://ioc-unesco.org/ec53. A major effort will be made by the Secretariat to prepare information and presentations well in advance of the session in the four official languages of the Commission and to facilitate discussion on the draft resolutions, decisions and recommendations through an updated Action Paper, within statutory deadlines. Detailed technical guidelines will be provided well ahead of the session and your remarks and thoughts on those will be sought to guide the efforts of the Officers and the Secretariat. I would also encourage you to actively take part in the work of the Intersessional Financial Advisory Group led by IOC Vice-chair Karim Hilmi in order to prepare our discussions on the Draft IOC Medium Strategy 2022-2029 (Draft 41 C/4) and Draft Programme and Budget 2022–2025 (Draft 41 C/5).

Under the current circumstances the working conditions for effectively exercising our governance are particularly challenging, and I have full confidence that with your understanding, commitment and collaboration we will jointly overcome these difficulties.

In the spirit of the IOC Rule of Procedure n° 23, I would like to seek consensus on the IOC Officers' proposal to hold the EC-53 session online as outlined in this letter. I urge each Member State of the Executive Council to respond to this letter **by 20 November 2020** and thank you in advance for your understanding and support.
