Summary

Empowering Women for the Ocean Decade aims to advance an alternative, inclusive model to enable more representative ocean science knowledge production to ensure gender equality and the empowerment of women of different ages and backgrounds at all levels. The Programme's research will identify outcomes which can be used in institutional capacity building and awareness raising. This includes the development of a baseline study on women's empowerment in selected intergovernmental organizations and non-governmental organizations concerned with ocean affairs. Research findings will identify key barriers and good practices which can inform the proposed Strategy and Action Plan. This will contribute to delivering equal opportunities for full participation and leadership by women at all levels of ocean science under the Ocean Decade. The Programme will enhance ongoing collaborations with partners to deliver substantive research outputs contributing to transformative actions.

- Collection and analysis of baseline gender-disaggregated data from selected international organizations and national institutions.

- Engagement with partners to co-develop knowledge and good practices on promoting gender equality and empowering women scientists.
- PhD and Post-doctoral capacity-development.
- Develop a Strategy and Action Plan for women's empowerment in the Ocean Decade.
- Publish and present research outputs.
