



1.a.2 Introductions and objectives of the Workshop

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- **The IOC Intergovernmental Coordination Group for the Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (ICG/IOTWMS)** at its 14th session (Banten, Indonesia, 17–19 November 2024, decided to organize an Indian Ocean Wave Exercise in 2025 (IOWave25) and established a Task Team to plan and conduct the exercise.
- **The Task Team IOWave25** decided to conduct IOWave25 with four different scenarios on 25 September, 15 October, 25 October and 5 November 2025.
- **The ICG/IOTWMS Steering Group** Meeting on 17-19 June 2025, the meeting requested the ICG/IOTWMS Secretariat, IOTIC, and the Task Team IOWave25 to consider organizing online pre-IOWave SOP workshop.
- **The Task Team IOWave25** coordination meeting held on 24 June 2025, the meeting decided to hold two hybrid three-day pre-IOWave SOP online workshops
