

National Tsunami Warning Chain Review Status 2020






Observations:





Issues for follow-up and future work



Madagascar - August 2025:

- 1. Implementation of SOPs at local level (authorities and public) and improvement of existing SOPs
- 2. Communication issues at remote areas (GSM network absent, road access)
- 3. Local capacity building (training, drilling, workshop...)
- 4. Improvement of tsunami modeling (high resolution map)
- 5. Establishment of evacuation strategy
- 6. Implementing the tsunami ready program
