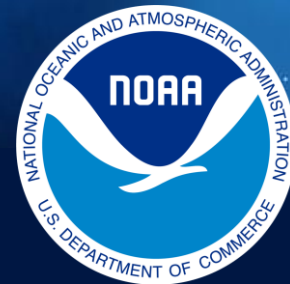

NOAA and State Department Partnership

- Five-year Interagency funding Agreement between NOAA and Department of State (DOS) in Office of International Disaster Response (IDR) in the Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration (PRM)
- State PRM IDR coordinates U.S. international disaster and humanitarian response efforts
- NOAA and DOS work jointly to identify projects across the globe to enhance readiness for hydrometeorological hazards, including tsunamis.
- NOAA provides expertise in weather observations, monitoring, analysis, and forecasting of hazards and possible consequences as well as readiness and response capabilities and last mile warning dissemination and communication
