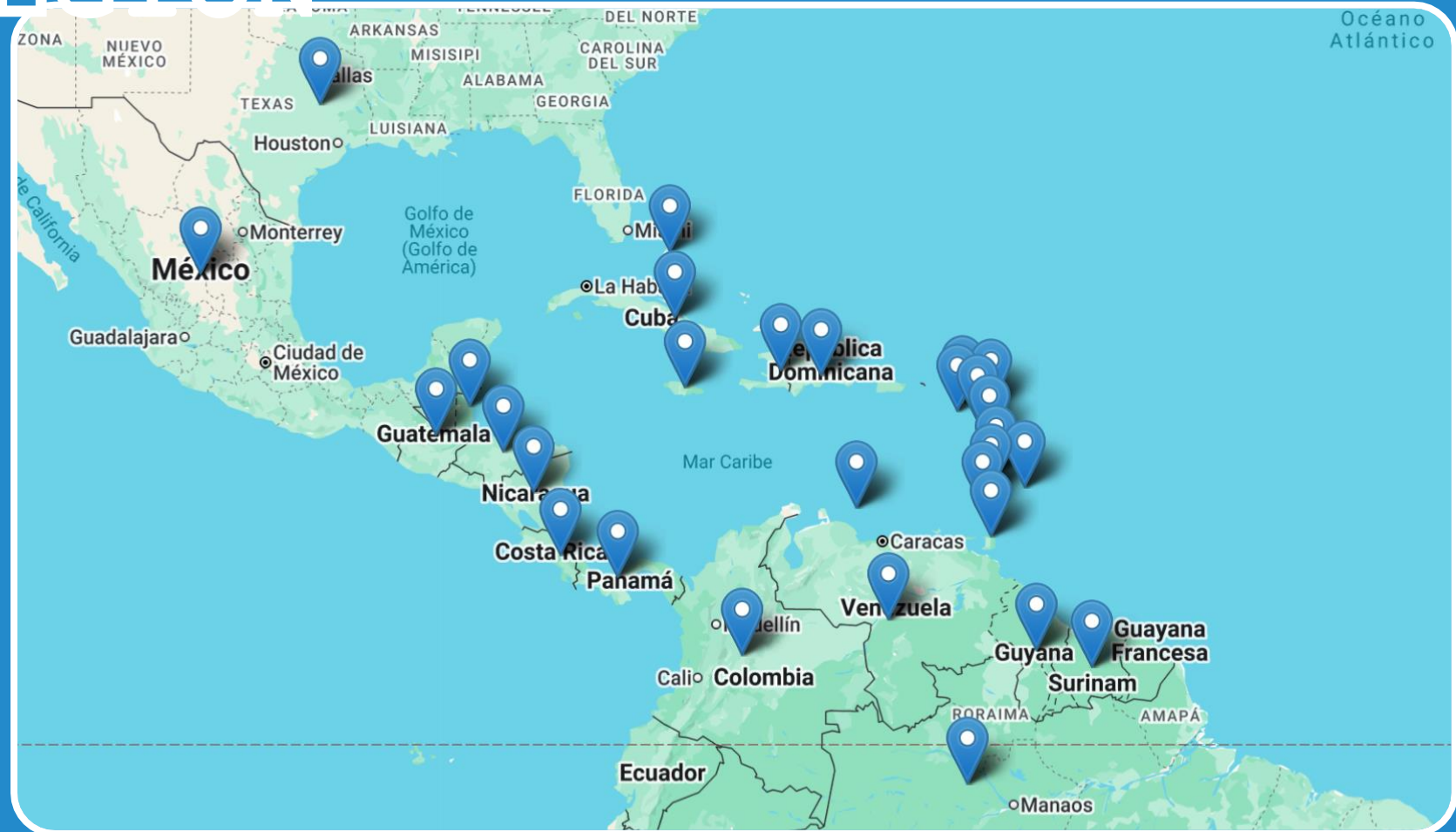


IOCARIBE REGION

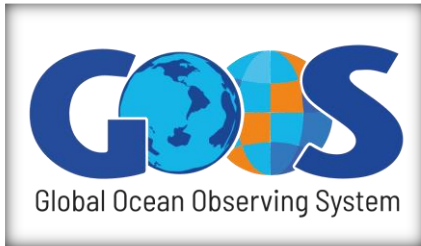

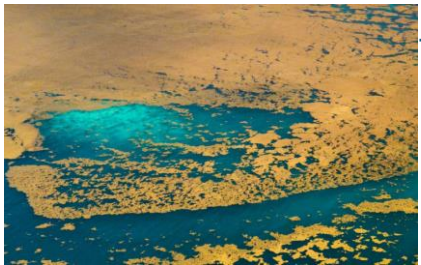
