ATLAS MARINO DEL CARIBE – CMA

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Objective

Operationalizing spatial data information-based online digital platform to support ICZM and ecosystem-based for LME in the Wider Caribbean region, as well as support the implementation of the CLME+ Strategic Action Programme (regional ocean governance).

Brings together at least **25** countries (**including CLME+**), **8** of which are actively providing national information and data (Trinidad & Tobago, Guatemala, Jamaica, Barbados, Belize , Dominican Republic, Mexico and Colombia)

Addressed to professionals in charge of planning and development, ministries and national and regional authorities, decision- and policy-makers.

Tools, data and information type:



The information management is driven through more than 50 GIS experts from different countries and entities, registered on platform and trained to manage national information from country pilots.
