- Preparedness and prevention, management, response and post disaster recover and societal resilience through capacity building, knowledge sharing and networking, and policy advice



- Support SIDS in benefitting from new generation of Early Warning System including Tsunami early warning systems,
 - Community readiness through the <u>UNESCO/IOC Tsunami Ready Recognition Programme</u>
- > SIDS capacity development in the field of marine science and technology
- Support in advancing ocean observation and data management through the Global Ocean Observing System (GOOS) and IOC Ocean Data and Information System (ODIS)
- Reinforcement of cooperation to address the specific challenges posed by sea-level rise, ocean pollution and acidification, loss of marine biodiversity, and coastal erosion
- Building resilience of vulnerable communities to climate change, and the regeneration of biodiversity stocks.
