- As per the PROCARIBE+ UNDP Project Document (ProDoc), **PROCARIBE+ is to be governed by a multi-stakeholder board/committee.**
- Such Project Board also called Project Steering Committee is to be established by the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS, the main PROCARIBE+ "Implementing Partner").
- The Board will not deal with the day-to-day project management, administration and execution.
- Day-to-day project management, administration and execution will be handled by UNOPS and the UNOPS-established regional PROCARIBE+ Project Management and Coordinating Unit (PMCU).



- The Board will seek to ensure that the Project's **delivery of results remains aligned** (*within the allowed* **tolerances**) with the **PROCARIBE+ ProDoc**, including its <u>Results Framework</u>, the associated <u>Work Plans</u> and <u>Budgets</u>, and **any revisions thereof approved by the Board**.
- The latter also means that there are <u>differentiated and complementary responsibilities</u> among all actors involved in the project
- The PROCARIBE+ Project Board became **formally established on 26 January 2024**, i.e. when a **simply majority** (11) of the PROCARIBE+ participating GEF-eligible countries had nominated their (main) Representative to the Project Board.
